Covid-19 has affected every part of our lives. The message from Government and Scientists is that the only way to move out of the pandemic is through a vaccine.

University Hospitals Birmingham (UHB) are now recruiting for up to 2000 roles to help roll out a national vaccine programme. They are seeking a range of people in clinical and non-clinical positions to work at five sites across Birmingham and Solihull. Jobs include:

Driver - to transport both hazardous and non-hazardous material

Marshalls - Indoor and outdoor to manage vehicle and people flow

Customer Services /Administration - managing bookings, paper /electronic records, greeting people

Clinical Practitioners - both registered and unregistered
