Covid-19 has affected every part of our lives. The message from Government and Scientists is that the only way to move out of the pandemic is through a vaccine .

University Hospitals Birmingham (UHB) are now recruiting for up to 2000 roles to help roll out a national vaccine programme. They are seeking a range of people in clinical and non-clinical positions to work at five sites across Birmingham and Solihull. Jobs include:

Driver - to transport both hazardous and non-hazardous material

Marshalls - Indoor and outdoor to manage vehicle and people flow

Stores and Logistics - movers to manage PPE distribution and deliveries

Health Care Assistants - to support people receiving the vaccine

Customer Services /Administration - managing bookings, paper /electronic records, greeting people

Clinical Practitioners - both registered and unregistered

Key information:

- Flexible shifts - 4, 8 or 12 hours, zero hours contract, though shifts can be block booked
- Employment contract is with UHB NHS Trust as part of our internal agency staff.
- Contracts will run mid December 2020 - March 2021

Centres will be open 7 days per week, 12 - 15 hours a day at five key locations in Birmingham and Solihull - more details to follow

How to Apply: Email the inbox, covidvaccineworkforce@uhb.nhs.uk stating the following:

1. The position you are interested in applying for (max of 3)
2. Your full name and up-to-date contact numbers
3. Your preferred geographical location
4. The days and hours per week you are available to work
5. Provide details of the skills and experience you have relevant to the roles you are applying for.
Example: *'I have worked as a delivery driver for 6 years, I have a clean driving licence and I am familiar with driving within the West Midlands area'*
6. Provide details of how you found out about the vacancy; (i.e. from Solihull Council's Employment Team)

On receipt of your email, a member of the recruitment team at UHB will contact you to discuss the information you have provided.
